

What is Double Parking?

Worksheet

Double parking is parking a second vehicle beside a legally parked car, blocking traffic or exit. Penalties include fines (₺500–₺5000 depending on region) and vehicle impoundment.

Questions

- Double parking is...
 - parking in a single lot space
 - parking beside another car illegally
 - parking with hazards on
 - parking in an angled spot
- What is the main danger of double parking?
 - wasted fuel
 - reduced visibility for cyclists
 - blocking the parked car's exit
 - difficulty removing the vehicle
- Can a double-parked car be towed?
 - only with owner permission
 - only if blocking fire hydrants
 - usually yes, especially if blocking traffic
 - never in residential areas
- Typical fine for double parking?
 - ₺100
 - ₺500–₺2500
 - ₺10,000
 - no penalty if < 10 min
- A car parks in a single lane beside a legally parked vehicle. The original owner cannot exit. Penalty?
- Double parking in a designated no-parking zone, near a fire hydrant.
- Second car parks 0.5 m away from the first, partially in a bike lane.
- Define: What is double parking?
- Define: Are there penalties for double parking?
- Define: Can police tow a double-parked car?

Answer Key

1. B) parking beside another car illegally — Double parking means parking alongside another vehicle, blocking it or traffic.
2. C) blocking the parked car's exit — It prevents the original car owner from leaving and blocks traffic flow.
3. C) usually yes, especially if blocking traffic — Police often tow double-parked cars to restore traffic flow.
4. B) ₺500-₺2500 — Fines range from ₺500-₺5000 depending on location and severity.
5. Violation: blocking traffic + obstructing exit Fine: ₺1,500-₺2,500 + possible towing Car may be impounded for 30 days
6. Violation: double parking + no-parking zone violation Fine: ₺2,500-₺5,000 Immediate towing likely
7. Violation: obstructing bike lane + double parking Fine: ₺1,000-₺2,000 Vehicle may be towed within 2 hours
8. Parking a second vehicle next to a legally parked car, blocking traffic or the car's exit.
9. Yes — fines (₺500-₺5000) and possible vehicle towing/impoundment.
10. Yes, in most jurisdictions, especially if blocking traffic or marked zones.

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
