

When Must You Use Headlights?

Worksheet

You must use headlights at night (dusk to dawn), in fog, rain, snow, darkness, low visibility, and in all tunnels — staying visible keeps everyone safe.

Questions

1. Turkish law requires headlights in tunnels...
 - A) only at night
 - B) only in winter
 - C) at all times
 - D) only if raining
2. You're driving in dense fog at 15:00. Should headlights be on?
 - A) No, it's daytime
 - B) Yes, low-beam lights
 - C) Only if oncoming traffic

3. What time must headlights be on in winter?
 - A) After 18:00
 - B) Dusk to dawn (approx. 17:00–08:00)
 - C) Only after 20:00
 - D) Never, winter is daytime
4. In heavy rain, low beam or high beam?

 - B) Low beam (dipped) to avoid glare

 - D) Hazard lights only
5. At 6:30 PM in winter, when must you switch on headlights?
6. You approach a fog bank on the highway. When must lights be on?
7. Entering a 2 km tunnel at 14:00 on a sunny day. Lights required?
8. Define: When must you use headlights?
9. Define: Do you need lights in a tunnel at noon?
10. Define: Difference between dipped and full beam?

Answer Key

1. C) at all times — All tunnels are dark regardless of time. Lights are always mandatory.
2. B) Yes, low-beam lights — Fog is low visibility. You must use dipped headlights for safety.
3. B) Dusk to dawn (approx. 17:00-08:00) — Dusk-dawn varies by season; roughly 17:00-08:00 in winter.
4. B) Low beam (dipped) to avoid glare — Dipped lights reduce glare on wet surfaces; high beam reflects off rain.
5. Winter dusk occurs around 17:00-17:30 At 6:30 PM, darkness is falling You must switch on low-beam headlights immediately.
6. Fog reduces visibility below normal daylight Fog qualifies as low-visibility condition Switch on headlights + hazard lights (if stopped)
7. Tunnels have no natural light, regardless of time Turkish law mandates headlights in ALL tunnels Yes, use low-beam headlights.
8. At night (dusk to dawn), in tunnels, and in low visibility (fog, rain, snow).
9. Yes — all tunnels require headlights, regardless of time.
10. Dipped (low) beam: normal use, safe for oncoming traffic. Full beam: only on empty roads at night.

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
