

What are Information Signs?

Worksheet

Information signs are blue rectangular traffic signs that show directions to services, facilities and public amenities such as hospitals, petrol stations, restaurants, rest areas and accommodation.

Answer Key

1. B) Blue rectangle — Information signs are always blue rectangles — the standard for service and facility directions.
2. A) Pump symbol — A petrol pump symbol on a blue sign indicates a fuel station.
3. C) Services and facilities — Information signs direct drivers to hospitals, restaurants, petrol stations, hotels and other useful amenities.
4. B) Food and drink venue — A fork and knife or restaurant symbol indicates food service nearby.
5. The 'H' on a blue rectangular sign indicates a hospital. This sign directs you to the nearest medical facility. Follow the arrow to find the hospital.
6. A bed symbol on a blue information sign indicates accommodation. This could be a hotel, motel, guesthouse or hostel. The arrow shows the direction to the facility.
7. A pump symbol indicates a fuel station. The arrow points left, meaning the station is to the left. You should turn left if you need to refuel.
8. Blue rectangles (mavi dikdörtgen) — this is the standard colour for service and facility signs.
9. Hospital — it directs you to the nearest medical facility.
10. Hospitals, fuel stations, restaurants, accommodation, rest areas, telephone booths and camping grounds.

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
