

What are Mandatory Signs (Mavi Daire)?

Worksheet

Mandatory signs are blue circles that command drivers to obey — they indicate required actions like direction, no U-turns, or parking in specific ways.

Questions

1. What color are mandatory traffic signs?
A) Red
B) Blue
C) White
D) Yellow
2. What does a blue circle with a straight arrow mean?
A) You may go straight
B) You must go straight
C) You cannot turn right
D) Optional direction
3. What is the main difference between a mandatory sign and a prohibition sign?
A) Both are the same
B) Mandatory = must do; Prohibition = cannot do
C) Mandatory = cannot do; Prohibition = must do

4. You see a blue sign with arrows for 'straight' and 'left' only. Can you turn right?

6. A mandatory sign shows a straight arrow and a left turn arrow. What are your choices?

Answer Key

1. B) Blue — Mandatory signs are always blue circles.
2. B) You must go straight — Mandatory signs require compliance — a straight arrow means you must proceed straight.
3. B) Mandatory = must do; Prohibition = cannot do — Mandatory (blue): required action. Prohibition (red): forbidden action.
4. C) No, right is not shown — Only the directions shown are allowed — turning right is implicitly forbidden.
5. 1. A blue circle is a mandatory sign — you must follow the instruction 2. The arrow points right, so you must turn right at this location 3. Ignoring this sign is illegal and may result in a fine
6. 1. Blue mandatory signs may show multiple options 2. You can proceed straight or turn left 3. You cannot turn right or make a U-turn — both are prohibited
7. 1. This is a compound mandatory sign 2. You are required to go straight in the driving lane 3. Parking is permitted only in the designated direction shown
8. Blue — mandatory signs are always blue circles (never red or white).
9. Required actions such as direction (straight, left, right), no U-turns, or specific behavior.
10. Mandatory (blue): 'You must do this.' Prohibitory (red with slash): 'You cannot do this.'

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
