

What are Minimum Speed Requirements?

Worksheet

Minimum speed requirements are the lowest legal speeds you must maintain on motorways and express roads. Driving slower than this minimum is illegal and disrupts traffic flow.

1. What is the minimum speed on a Turkish motorway for a car?

Answer Key

1. C) 90 km/h — The legal minimum speed on Turkish motorways for cars is 90 km/h.
2. B) No, never — No — minimum speed rules apply regardless of traffic unless forced by congestion or emergencies.
3. B) 65 km/h — Trucks and buses must maintain a minimum of 65 km/h on express highways.
4. B) To maintain flow and reduce accidents — Minimum speeds maintain traffic flow and reduce accidents caused by unexpectedly slow vehicles.
5. 1. Check road type — this is a motorway 2. Consult minimum speed rules — motorway minimum is 90 km/h for cars 3. Maintain at least 90 km/h 4. Do not drive slower or you risk a fine and disrupt traffic
6. 1. Identify road type — express highway 2. Check truck classification — this is a commercial vehicle 3. Minimum for trucks on express highways is 65 km/h 4. Maintain this speed to comply with traffic law
7. 1. Heavy congestion may temporarily reduce safe speeds 2. If traffic forces you slower, you are not liable 3. However, try to maintain minimum when safely possible 4. Once congestion clears, return to minimum speed
8. Legal minimum speeds you must maintain on motorways and express roads to ensure traffic flow and safety.
9. 90 km/h for cars; 80 km/h for trucks and buses.
10. 75 km/h for cars; 65 km/h for trucks.

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
