

# What are Overtaking and Passing Rules?

## Worksheet

Overtaking is passing another vehicle. Rules require no solid yellow lines, clear oncoming sight distance ( $\geq 300$  m), proper signaling, and returning to the right lane smoothly.

## Questions

1. Road has dashed yellow line on your side and 350 m oncoming visibility. Can you overtake?  
A) No, never overtake  
B) Yes, conditions allow  
C) Only if other car signals  
D) Only during daytime
2. Solid yellow line on your side. What does this mean?  
A) Overtaking encouraged  
B) Overtaking forbidden on your side  
C) Both sides can overtake  
D) Only trucks can overtake
3. You see an oncoming car 200 m away. Safe to overtake?  
A) Yes, start now  
B) No, not enough distance  
C) Yes, if you speed up  
D) Only at night
4. After overtaking, when should you return to the right lane?  
A) Immediately  
B) When 100 m ahead of the passed car  
C) After signaling right and ensuring the way is clear  
D) At the next intersection
5. You approach a car going 80 km/h while you are capable of 100 km/h. Check the road: single yellow line (dashed), clear view 400 m ahead. Can you overtake?
6. Solid yellow line on your side of the road. The car ahead is slow. Can you overtake?
7. Oncoming car visible 250 m away and slowing. Another car 50 m ahead. Should you overtake?
8. Define: When is overtaking legal?
9. Define: What does a solid yellow line mean?
10. Define: Should you signal before overtaking?

## Answer Key

1. B) Yes, conditions allow — Dashed line permits overtaking; 350 m exceeds minimum 300 m requirement.
2. B) Overtaking forbidden on your side — Solid yellow line = no passing on that side.
3. B) No, not enough distance — Need  $\geq 300$  m clear sight distance; 200 m is insufficient.
4. C) After signaling right and ensuring the way is clear — Return to right lane only after adequate spacing and confirming safety.
5. Road markings: dashed yellow line (overtaking allowed) Oncoming visibility: 400 m  $>$  300 m required Signal left and smoothly enter left lane Accelerate past vehicle and return to right lane
6. Road markings: solid yellow line on your side Solid line means overtaking prohibited You must not enter the left lane; follow the car
7. Oncoming distance: 250 m  $<$  300 m required minimum Not enough sight distance; overtaking unsafe Wait behind the car until sight improves
8. When road markings allow (no solid line on your side) and you have  $\geq 300$  m clear oncoming visibility.
9. No overtaking allowed on the side with the solid line.
10. Yes — signal left before moving to the left lane, then signal right before returning.
