

What are Parking Regulations?

Worksheet

Parking regulations define legal zones, time limits and conditions for stopping your vehicle. Violations result in fines, vehicle immobilization or towing.

Questions

1. In a 'no-parking' zone, can you stop for 30 seconds?
A) Yes, briefly is allowed
B) No, stopping is prohibited
C) Yes, if hazard lights are on
D) Only for emergencies
2. Parking in a disabled space without a permit results in:
A) Warning only
B) ₺100-300 fine
C) ₺1,100+ fine and possible towing
D) License suspension
3. A green-zone sign shows '2H'. After 1 hour 50 minutes, you move your car. What's the fine?
A) ₺200
B) ₺0 (no violation)
C) ₺400-600 depending on location
D) Car is towed
4. Which parking zone type allows indefinite parking (no time limit)?
A) Green zones
B) Blue zones
C) Parking lots designated as 'free'
D) Only residential streets
5. Can I park in a 'no-parking' zone for 5 minutes to drop someone off?
6. A green-zone sign says '2 hours'. I park for 2 hours 15 minutes. What's the penalty?
7. Is it legal to park in a disabled parking space?
8. Define: What is a 'no-parking' zone?
9. Define: How long can you park in a green-zone area?
10. Define: Who can legally park in a disabled parking space?

Answer Key

1. B) No, stopping is prohibited — 'No-parking' zones prohibit all stopping, even briefly. Exceptions are rare and must be clearly marked.
2. C) ₺1,100+ fine and possible towing — Reserved spaces are protected by law. Fines are high (₺1,100–2,000 in Turkey) to protect disabled access.
3. B) ₺0 (no violation) — You stayed within the 2-hour limit, so no violation. No fine applies.
4. C) Parking lots designated as 'free' — Designated free parking lots have no time limit. Green and blue zones are time-limited or paid.
5. Check the sign: 'no-parking' means no stopping allowed. No exceptions for drop-offs in absolute no-parking zones. Result: Parking here risks a fine (₺300–1,000) or towing.
6. Time exceeded by 15 minutes. Fine for overstaying: typically ₺400–700 depending on location. If vehicle is unattended, it may be towed.
7. Only with a valid disabled permit displayed. Parking without authorization: ₺1,100–2,000 fine (Turkey) + immediate towing. These spaces are reserved by law.
8. An area where stopping and parking are completely prohibited, even briefly.
9. The time limit shown on the sign (e.g., 2 hours). Exceeding it results in a fine.
10. Only vehicles displaying a valid disabled-person permit on the dashboard.

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
