

What are Passing and Overtaking Rules?

Worksheet

Passing is prohibited over solid double lines, near curves, intersections, hills, and crests. Safe overtaking requires 100+ meters of clear visibility ahead, proper signaling, and ensuring no oncoming traffic is within safe distance.

Questions

1. Passing is prohibited...

2. Can you overtake on a curve?

6. A curve is ahead and the road is clear. Is it safe to overtake?
7. You have 150 meters of clear visibility ahead. Can you safely overtake?
8. Define: When is passing prohibited?
9. Define: What does a solid double line mean for passing?
10. Define: How much clear visibility is needed to safely overtake?

Answer Key

1. B) Over solid lines — Solid double lines mark no-passing zones in all conditions.
2. B) No, visibility is limited — Curves hide oncoming traffic — never overtake on curves.
3. C) 100+ meters — Most traffic codes require 100+ meters of clear, unobstructed visibility ahead.
4. C) Left turn signal — Left signal indicates intention to change lanes and pass.
5. Solid double line = no passing zone Answer: No — passing is strictly prohibited over solid lines.
6. Curves reduce visibility and control Answer: No — never pass on curves or hills; reduced visibility = collision risk.
7. Safe overtaking requires 100+ meters visibility (this is 150, sufficient) But also check: no solid line, no intersection, straight road ahead Answer: Only if all other conditions are met.
8. Over solid lines, near curves/hills, near intersections, or when visibility is poor.
9. No passing allowed in either direction; strict no-passing zone.
10. Minimum 100+ meters of clear road ahead with no oncoming traffic.

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
