

What are Prohibition Signs?

Worksheet

Prohibition signs are red circles with a slash through a symbol that forbid actions such as 'no entry,' 'no parking,' or 'no passing.' Violating a prohibition sign incurs a traffic violation or fine.

Questions

1. What shape and color indicate a prohibition sign?

Answer Key

1. B) Red circle with slash — Prohibition signs are red circles with a slash.
2. B) Parking — Red circle with 'P' and slash = no parking.
3. B) Warning alerts; prohibition forbids — Warning signs alert to hazards; prohibition signs forbid actions.
4. B) Yes, 'no parking 8am-6pm' for example — Many prohibition signs include time restrictions; always check for details.
5. This is a 'no parking' prohibition sign. It forbids parking in this area, possibly only at certain times (check time restrictions). Parking here results in a fine or tow.
6. This is a 'no right turn' prohibition sign. It forbids turning right at this location. Turning right here violates the rule and may incur a fine.
7. This is a 'no entry' prohibition sign. It forbids all vehicles from entering this area. Entering when posted violates traffic law.
8. Red circle with a slash or cross through a symbol.
9. Specific actions like no entry, no parking, no passing, no honking.
10. You incur a traffic violation, fine, and possible loss of driving privileges.

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
