

Seatbelt Use Requirements

Answer Key

1. C) Everyone with a seatbelt available — All occupants in seating positions with seatbelts must wear them.
2. C) €50-500+ — Seatbelt fines typically range from €50 to €500 or more, plus license points.
3. C) Yes, for all driving — Seatbelts are mandatory for all trips, regardless of distance or location.
4. C) The driver and traffic laws — Drivers are responsible for ensuring passengers comply with seatbelt laws.
5. Both you and the passenger face fines. The driver is legally responsible for passenger compliance in many jurisdictions. You must request the passenger buckle up or stop driving.
6. Most countries require children under 5 to use child seats, not standard seatbelts. Child seats provide proper positioning and protection. Using adult seatbelts on young children is dangerous and illegal.
7. Yes — seatbelts are required at ALL times and distances. Most crashes occur at low speeds and short distances. Wearing a seatbelt is not optional.
8. Drivers and all passengers in seating positions with available seatbelts.
9. At all times while the vehicle is in motion, regardless of distance or speed.
10. Fines vary by jurisdiction, typically €50-500+, plus license points.
