Answer Key

1. B) Speeding Category 2 — Speeding 30+ km/h over = Category 2. Fine ~₺2,000, 18 points.
2. B) ₺300–₺500 — Parking violations carry ~₺300–₺500 fines.
3. C) Equipment defect — Equipment violations (lights, brakes, etc.) are a separate category.
4. C) Expired license — License/document violations are Category 1 (serious): ~₺800–₺1,500, 25+ points.
5. Speeding >40 km/h over limit = Category 2 violation Fine: ~₺2,000–₺3,000 Demerit points: 18 points
6. Parking violation = Category 3 Fine: ~₺300–₺500 Demerit points: 4 points
7. License/document violation = Category 1 (serious) Fine: ~₺800–₺1,500 Demerit points: 25 points
8. Groupings of violations — speeding, parking, license, equipment — each with different fines and point values.
9. 18–20 points, depending on exact excess.
10. ~₺300–₺500 and 4–6 demerit points.

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
