

What Are Mandatory Traffic Signs (Blue)?

Worksheet

Mandatory signs are blue with white symbols and command drivers to follow specific routes or lanes: directional arrows (→), one-way roads, keep-right, designated pedestrian/bicycle paths, and bus lanes. Violating them risks fines and accidents.

Questions

1. Mandatory traffic sign background color?

- A) Red
- B) White
- C) Blue
- D) Yellow

2. Blue arrow pointing left. What must you do?

- A) Can turn left if you want
- B) MUST turn left — it's mandatory
- C) Suggest turning left
- D) Left is optional

3. One-way street, blue sign, you want to go the opposite direction. Can you?

- A) Yes, if few cars
- B) No — always prohibited
- C) Yes, after 10 PM
- D) Yes, on weekends

4. Blue sign shows a bicycle path. Drivers allowed?

Answer Key

1. C) Blue — Blue = mandatory instruction. Red/white = warning. Yellow = caution.
2. B) MUST turn left — it's mandatory — Blue signs are commands, not suggestions. An arrow must be followed.
3. B) No — always prohibited — One-way is absolute; direction enforcement is continuous (24/7, all days).
4. C) No — exclusive for bicycles and pedestrians — Blue path signs designate exclusive zones. Drivers must use regular lanes.
5. Sign color: blue (mandatory) Symbol: rightward arrow Action: you MUST turn right or continue in right lane Consequence: ignoring results in fine and/or collision
6. Sign type: mandatory (blue) Rule: one-way means traffic in one direction only Light traffic: does not override the law Result: going opposite is ILLEGAL and dangerous
7. Sign: blue pedestrian path indicator Meaning: exclusive zone for pedestrians/cyclists Driver action: must NOT enter; use driving lanes Result: drivers in pedestrian zone face fines
8. Blue background with white symbols. They command drivers to follow specific routes or restrictions.
9. You must turn right or stay in the right lane. It is mandatory, not optional.
10. No — one-way signs are always mandatory, regardless of traffic volume. Violating results in a fine.

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
