

What are Traffic Violations and Penalties?

Traffic violations are illegal driving behaviors (speeding, running lights, reckless driving). Penalties include fines (₺500-₺5000+), points deduction, license suspension, or vehicle impound.

Answer Key

1. B) ₺500-1000 fine — Minor speeding (5-20 km/h over) typically costs ₺500-1000.
2. B) Running red light with accident — Violations causing accidents are the most serious due to injury/property damage risk.
3. D) All of the above — Too many points lead to suspension; insurers also raise rates.
4. B) Vehicle impound; fine ₺2500-5000 — No insurance is severe; vehicle is impounded until proof is provided.
5. Exceeding the speed limit is a minor to moderate violation. Base fine: ₺1000-1500 depending on the zone and jurisdiction. If it's a construction zone, the fine doubles to ₺2000-3000. Demerit points are typically deducted from the license (1-3 points).
6. Running a red light is a moderate violation (₺1500-2500 fine). Causing an accident increases severity; fine rises to ₺3000-4000. Demerit points: 4-6 (more serious because of collision). If injury occurs, criminal charges may apply in addition.
7. Operating without insurance is a severe violation (₺2500-5000 fine). The vehicle may be impounded until proof of insurance is provided. Demerit points: 6-12 points, depending on prior violations. In some jurisdictions, license suspension may occur after impound.
8. An illegal driving behavior that breaches road laws and endangers safety.
9. Typically ₺500-1000 depending on the zone and jurisdiction.
10. Fine of ₺1500-2500, demerit points, and possible vehicle impound if involved in collision.
