

What Vehicle Documents Are Required?

Required vehicle documents are the registration certificate (Ruhsat), valid insurance, roadworthiness certificate (Muayene Belgesi), and proof of emission inspection — all mandatory for legal road use.

Answer Key

1. B) Registration certificate (Ruhsat) — Ruhsat is the official ownership and identification document.
2. B) Every 1 year — Annual inspection (Muayene) is mandatory; can be renewed 30 days before expiration.
3. D) All of the above — Driving with expired insurance incurs fines, demerit points, and the car may be impounded.
4. C) Roadworthiness (includes emission test) — Emission inspection (Egzoz) is part of the annual roadworthiness (Muayene) check.
5. Insurance must be valid at all times. Your car is not legal to drive with expired insurance. You must renew insurance BEFORE expiration date. Driving without valid insurance = fine + points.
6. Muayene must be renewed within 30 days before expiration. You can renew at any authorized inspection center. Check emissions (Egzoz) during inspection. Renew NOW if expiring within 1 month.
7. Contact the local Traffic Police Directorate (Trafik Polis Müdürlüğü). File a report (zabita muhasebesi) and request a duplicate. Provide proof of identity and vehicle details. Obtain duplicate Ruhsat, usually within days.
8. Ruhsat — ownership and vehicle identity document.
9. 1 year for standard vehicles; must be renewed at an authorized inspection center.
10. Mechanical condition, emissions (Egzoz), lights, brakes, and structural safety.
