

What are Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance Requirements?

Worksheet

Vehicle inspection requires annual roadworthiness certification testing brakes, lights, emissions, tires, and steering. Failure to inspect incurs fines and the vehicle cannot legally operate.

Questions

1. A vehicle's inspection expired 1 month ago. What is the result if stopped?
A) Verbal warning

2. Which is checked during vehicle inspection?
A) Oil level only

Answer Key

1. C) Fine ₺1000-2000 and impound — Overdue inspection incurs a fine and vehicle impound until current.
2. B) Brakes, lights, tires, emissions — Inspections verify safety systems and emissions compliance.
3. C) 1.6 mm — Legal minimum tread depth is 1.6 mm; below this, tires are unsafe.
4. B) Annually — Vehicles older than 4 years require annual inspection in most jurisdictions.
5. No — driving with an expired inspection is illegal. The fine is ₺1000-2000 depending on jurisdiction. The vehicle must be inspected before legally driving again. If stopped, police will impound the vehicle until inspection is current.
6. The brakes must be repaired before resubmission. The car cannot be legally driven until brakes pass inspection. Once repaired, the vehicle must be re-inspected at an authorized center. Re-inspection typically costs ₺100-200.
7. Vehicles older than 4 years typically require annual inspection. At 12 years, the inspection is mandatory every year (not every 2 years). Emissions testing is more rigorous for older vehicles. If emissions fail, repairs are required before re-inspection.
8. An annual safety and emissions test ensuring brakes, lights, tires, and emissions meet legal standards.
9. Brake system, lighting, tire tread depth (min. 1.6 mm), and emissions (CO, NOx).
10. Typically ₺1000-2000 depending on how long overdue and jurisdiction.

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
