

What are White Lane Markings?

Worksheet

White lane markings define road lanes: solid white lines separate lanes (do not cross), dashed white lines allow lane changes when safe.

Questions

1. What does a solid white line mean?

Answer Key

1. B) Do not cross this line — Solid white lines are permanent lane separators — drivers must not cross them.
2. B) Cross if safe and signalling — Dashed lines allow lane changes when safe and when signalling your intent.
3. B) No, it is forbidden — Solid white lines are permanent separators — crossing them is forbidden.
4. B) Signal and check mirrors — Before crossing any line, signal your intent and check that it is safe.
5. Solid white line = permanent lane separation. You cannot cross a solid white line. You must stay in your current lane until the line changes or ends.
6. Dashed white line = crossing allowed. If it is safe and you signal, you can change lanes or pass. Always check mirrors and ensure no traffic is coming.
7. Dashed line = crossing is permitted. However, the road is busy with traffic. Only cross if it is safe — check mirrors and ensure enough space before changing lanes.
8. A solid white line separates lanes permanently — drivers must not cross it.
9. A dashed white line marks a lane boundary — drivers can cross if safe and when signalling.
10. No — solid lines are permanent lane separators. You cannot cross them.

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
