1. B) on — 'on' means on top of the surface. The keys are resting on the desk.
2. B) a word showing position/time/direction — Prepositions show relationships like location, time, and direction.
3. C) toward — 'toward' (or to, from, across) shows movement and direction.
4. C) at — 'at' is used for specific times. 'at 3 o'clock' is correct.
5. The book is inside the bag. Use 'in' for something inside a container. Answer: The book is in the bag.
6. She is at a specific location — the table. Use 'at' for a specific point. Answer: She sat at the table.
7. The cat is in the middle of two chairs. Use 'between' for something in the middle of two things. Answer: The cat sat between the two chairs.
8. A small word that shows the relationship between a noun and other words — like position, time, or direction.
9. in, on, at, under, near, between, above, below, behind, in front of
10. in = inside; on = on top of surface; at = specific point (at the table, at school)
