Answer Key

1. B) Purple — Red + blue = purple, a secondary color.
2. B) White — White is the lightest; black is the darkest.

5. A ripe apple is typically red. Answer: Red
6. On a clear day, the sky appears blue. Answer: Blue
7. Fresh spring leaves are typically green. Answer: Green
8. Red — a bright warm color.
9. Blue, green, or purple — they feel calm and cool.
10. White — the lightest color.

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
