1. B) Acquiring knowledge, skills, and personal development for life success — Education and learning aim to develop knowledge, critical thinking, skills, and capabilities for personal, professional, and social success.
2. B) Yes, learning from online courses, books, and experience is education too — Yes — informal learning (online courses, tutorials, self-study, mentoring) is valid education outside formal institutions.
3. B) Continuous acquisition of new knowledge and skills throughout life — Lifelong learning is the ongoing pursuit of knowledge and skill development throughout a person's entire life.
4. B) Classroom, online, practice, experience, and self-study combined — Education and learning encompasses formal instruction, online learning, practical experience, self-study, and mentoring.
5. Yes — this is formal education Schools provide structured instruction Certified teachers guide learning Students gain recognized qualifications
6. Yes — this is self-directed or informal learning No formal institution is required Individuals can learn independently Practice and experience drive growth
