

What is Future Continuous?

Worksheet

Future continuous shows an action in progress at a particular time in the future: 'I will be studying at 8 PM' or 'She will be flying to London next week.' It emphasizes the ongoing nature of the action.

Questions

1. Which is future continuous?

Answer Key

1. B) I will be going to the gym at 6 PM. — 'I will be going to the gym at 6 PM' shows the action in progress at a specific time.
2. C) They will be studying when you arrive. — Future continuous: will + be + base verb + ing.
3. B) An action in progress at a specific future moment. — Future continuous emphasizes an ongoing action at a particular time in the future.
4. B) At midnight, I will be sleeping. — 'At midnight, I will be sleeping' shows an action in progress at that specific time.
5. Specific time in future: 8 PM Action in progress at that time: studying Say: 'I will be studying at 8 PM.' Emphasizes the ongoing action at that moment.
6. Specific time: Monday during the flight Action in progress: traveling Say: 'She will be flying to Paris on Monday.' Shows action happening during that time.
7. Specific time: next year, same date Action in progress: working/living somewhere Say: 'I will be working in a new city.' Shows ongoing state at that future moment.
8. For actions that will be in progress at a specific moment in the future.
9. 'Will do' = complete action; 'will be doing' = action in progress at a specific time.
10. 'At 9 AM tomorrow, I will be having breakfast.' Shows action happening at that moment.

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
