

What is Future Simple with Will?

Future simple is will + base verb, used for future actions and predictions. Example: I will call you tomorrow.

Answer Key

1. A) will go — will go = future simple (will + base verb).
2. C) will + base verb — Future simple = will + infinitive (base verb without to).
3. B) I will call. (just decided) — will + verb shows a spontaneous decision made right now.
4. B) won't — will not → won't (irregular contraction).
5. will attend = future simple (decided/promised) Time: tomorrow at 10 AM (future) Formation: will + base verb (attend)
6. will win = future simple (prediction) Adverb: probably (adds emphasis to prediction) Formation: will + base verb (win)
7. will not forget = negative future simple Adverb placement: between will and verb Formation: will + not/n't + base verb
8. A tense using will + base verb for future actions, predictions, and spontaneous decisions.
9. will + base verb. Example: will go, will eat, will study.
10. will = spontaneous/prediction; going to = planned decision.

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
