Answer Key

1. C) 12 — There are exactly 12 months in a year: January through December.
2. B) July — The correct order is June → July → August. July is the 7th month.
3. A) 28 — February usually has 28 days. It has 29 in leap years (every 4 years).
4. C) January — January is the first month and marks the beginning of the new year.
5. Looking at the sequence: January → February → March → April April comes after March.
6. February is the second month. In a regular year, February has 28 days. In a leap year, February has 29 days.
7. Autumn starts in September and ends in November. The three autumn months are September, October, and November.
