

What Are Personal Pronouns?

Personal pronouns are words that replace nouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they. They vary by person (1st, 2nd, 3rd), number (singular/plural), and can be subjects or objects.

1. A) He — Tom is male (3rd person singular) → he.

3. C) It — An animal (unknown gender) = 3rd person singular → it.
4. B) me — After a verb, use object pronoun: help me.
5. Maria (3rd person singular female) Replace with: she Answer: She studies every day.
6. John and I = 1st person plural Replace with: we Answer: We like soccer.
7. Book = 3rd person singular (it) Replace with: it Answer: It is on the table.
