

What are Possessive Pronouns?

Worksheet

Possessive pronouns are pronouns that show ownership. The list includes: mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs. They replace a possessive adjective + noun (e.g., 'my car' → 'mine').

2. Replace 'their car' with a possessive pronoun.

- A) theirs car
- B) the car is theirs

4. Which sentence uses a possessive pronoun correctly?

Answer Key

1. B) mine — Mine is the possessive pronoun. 'My house is mine.'
2. B) the car is theirs — 'The car is theirs' or just 'theirs' replaces 'their car'.
3. B) adjective — 'Our' is an adjective. The pronoun is 'ours'.
4. B) This car is his. — 'This car is his' correctly uses the possessive pronoun.
5. Replace 'your bike' with a possessive pronoun. The answer: It's yours. or The bike is yours.
6. Use a possessive pronoun for 'their apartment'. The apartment is theirs.
7. My cat: the cat is mine. His dog: the dog is his. We compare two pets.
8. Words that show ownership, replacing a possessive adjective + noun.
9. mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs
10. Adjective: comes before noun (my book). Pronoun: replaces the noun (mine).

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
