

How to Form Questions in Present Tense?

Worksheet

Form present tense questions by placing 'Do' or 'Does' at the start: Do you like it? Does she work? (I/you/we/they use Do; he/she/it uses Does).

Questions

1. Convert 'You play soccer' to a question.
A) You do play soccer?
B) Do you play soccer?
C) Plays you soccer?
D) Do you soccer play?
2. Which is the correct question?
A) Does she likes cats?
B) She does like cats?
C) Does she like cats?
D) Does she likes?
3. Form a question with 'They work here.'
A) Do they work here?
B) Does they work here?
C) Do they works here?
D) Them do work here?
4. What is the short answer to 'Does it rain'?
A) No, it not rains.
B) Yes, it does.
C) Yes, it is.
D) No, it do.
5. Convert to a question: 'You like pizza.'
6. Convert to a question: 'He plays football.'
7. Convert to a question: 'They go to school.'

Answer Key

1. B) Do you play soccer? — You (plural) uses Do. Correct order: Do + you + play + soccer?
2. C) Does she like cats? — She (singular) uses Does. Verb reverts to base: Does she like cats?
3. A) Do they work here? — They (plural) uses Do: Do they work here?
4. B) Yes, it does. — Short answer: Yes, it does. / No, it doesn't.
5. Identify: you (uses Do) Word order: Do + you + like + pizza + ? Question: Do you like pizza?
6. Identify: he (uses Does) Word order: Does + he + play + football + ? Question: Does he play football?
7. Identify: they (uses Do) Word order: Do + they + go + to + school + ? Question: Do they go to school?
8. Place Do/Does at the start: Do you...? Does she...?
9. Do with I/you/we/they; Does with he/she/it.
10. Do/Does + Subject + Verb: Do you like it?

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
