Weather vocabulary consists of words describing atmospheric conditions: sunny, rainy, snowy, cloudy, windy, hot, cold, warm, mild, humid, foggy, stormy, etc. Knowing these helps you talk about weather and understand forecasts.

Answer Key

1. B) cloudy — Cloudy describes a day with many clouds covering the sky.
2. C) snowy — Snowy describes weather with snow falling.
3. C) freezing — Freezing means very cold, usually at or below 0°C.
4. C) windy — Windy describes weather with strong or noticeable wind.
5. Temperature: 25°C = mild/warm. No clouds = clear sky. Weather: 'It is warm and sunny today.'
6. Wind speed 40 km/h is moderate to strong. Weather word: 'windy' or 'breezy'. Sentence: 'It is very windy outside.'
7. Temperature: 0°C = freezing/cold. Precipitation: snow. Weather: 'It is cold and snowy.' or 'It is freezing with snow.'
8. Sunny, clear, bright
9. Rainy or wet
10. Snowy

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
