Answer Key

1. B) arm — Bras = arm. One of the most commonly used body part words.
2. B) cœur — Cœur = heart. Pronounced 'kur.' Used in expressions of emotion too.
3. C) pied — Pied = foot. Jambe is the leg from hip to foot.
4. B) finger — Doigt = finger. Also used for toes (doigt de pied = toe).
5. 'Mon bras me fait mal.' (My arm hurts me.) Or: 'J'ai mal au bras.' (I have pain in the arm.) Both are equally correct in French medical conversation.
6. Tête = head Yeux = eyes Nez = nose Bouche = mouth Cœur = heart
7. 'Je me suis tordu la cheville.' Cheville = ankle (feminine) Tordu = twisted Perfect past tense structure.
