Answer Key

1. B) pants — Pantalon = pants. Always singular in French even when referring to one pair.
2. B) chaussures — Chaussures = shoes. Chaussettes = socks, sandales = sandals, bottes = boots.
3. C) jacket — Veste = jacket. Often worn over a shirt (chemise) in formal settings.
4. A) Avez-vous ma taille? — 'Avez-vous ma taille?' (Do you have my size?) — a standard fitting room question.
5. 'Quelle est votre taille?' (What size are you?) Or: 'Je fais la taille M' (I wear size M) Sizes: XS, S, M, L, XL, XXL are often used in French stores too.
6. Robe = dress Chemise = shirt Pantalon = pants Chaussures = shoes Chaussettes = socks
7. 'J'aime ton pull.' (I like your sweater — casual) Or 'J'aime votre pull' (formal) Pull = pullover/sweater
