Answer Key

1. B) l'école — 'L'école' = school (feminine). 'Classe' = classroom/class, 'étudiant' = student, 'professeur' = teacher.
2. B) J'ai un examen demain — 'J'ai un examen demain' = I have an exam tomorrow. 'Cours' = class/lesson, 'vais à l'école' = go to school.
3. B) le professeur — 'Le professeur' = teacher/professor. 'Directeur' = principal, 'élève' = pupil, 'étudiant' = student.
4. B) difficile — 'Difficile' = difficult (feminine form for 'examen'). 'Facile' = easy, 'moyen' = average.
5. Student = étudiant (male) or étudiante (female) Sentence: Je suis étudiant(e). = I am a student.
6. Exam = l'examen (masculine) Sentence: L'examen est difficile. = The exam is difficult.
7. Teacher = le professeur or Madame/Monsieur Example: Bonjour, Madame. (Hello, ma'am)
