Answer Key

1. D) both A and C — Both 'la mère' and 'la maman' (informal) mean mother.
2. A) mon frère — 'Frère' is masculine, so 'mon' (my, masc.) is correct.
3. B) aunt — 'Tante' = aunt; 'oncle' = uncle.
4. A) mes soeurs — Plural possessive: 'mes' (my, plural). 'Mes soeurs' = my sisters.
5. Mère = mother (feminine) Pronoun: ma (my, feminine) Answer: C'est ma mère.
6. Soeur = sister; frère = brother 'Are here' = sont là Answer: Ma soeur et mon frère sont là.
7. Aunt = tante (fem.); uncle = oncle (masc.) Have = ai Answer: J'ai une tante et un oncle.
