1. A) bread — Pain = bread. One of the most common French foods.
2. B) Je voudrais de l'eau — De l'eau = water. A polite request in a restaurant.
3. C) croissant — Croissant is iconic French breakfast pastry.
4. B) I would like — Je voudrais = I would like — polite for ordering.
5. First, get attention: 'Excusez-moi!' (Excuse me!) Then order: 'Je voudrais un croissant et un café, s'il vous plaît.' Translation: I would like a croissant and a coffee, please.
6. Carotte (carrot) Brocoli (broccoli) Tomate (tomato)
7. Petit déjeuner = breakfast Déjeuner = lunch Dîner = dinner
