1. B) Déjeuner (lunch) — Déjeuner (lunch) is the main meal in France, typically eaten midday.
2. B) Bread — Pain means bread — an essential word for food shopping in France.
3. B) Main course — Plat principal means 'main course' — the main dish of a meal.
4. B) Je voudrais... — Je voudrais... ('I would like...') is polite for ordering in restaurants.
5. Breakfast is light in France. Typical foods: bread (pain), butter (beurre), jam (confiture), coffee (café). Example: Je prends du pain avec du beurre et de la confiture le matin. Translation: I eat bread with butter and jam in the morning.
6. Lunch is the main meal of the day. Structure: appetizer (entrée), main course (plat principal), cheese (fromage), dessert (dessert). Example: Je mange une salade, puis un steak avec des légumes, du fromage et un gâteau. Translation: I eat a salad, then a steak with vegetables, cheese and a cake.
7. Waiter: Vous désirez? (What would you like?) You: Je voudrais une soupe à l'oignon et du poulet rôti. Translation: I would like onion soup and roasted chicken. Waiter: Et à boire? (And to drink?) You: Un verre de vin blanc, s'il vous plaît. Translation: A glass of white wine, please.
8. Words for foods, meals, dishes, ingredients, cooking methods, and dining customs.
9. Petit déjeuner (or déjeuner in older usage).
10. Lunch — the midday meal (the main meal in France).
