

What are Aller and Venir?

Worksheet

Aller means 'to go' (Je vais au café = I go to the café); venir means 'to come' (Je viens demain = I come tomorrow). Both are irregular verbs with unique conjugations.

Answer Key

1. B) Je vais au marché — 'Aller' means 'to go'. 'Au' = 'à le' (to the). 'Je vais au marché' is correct.
2. B) venez — 'Venir' (to come) + formal 'vous' = 'venez'
3. C) Aller — 'Aller' is highly irregular — it doesn't follow standard verb patterns.
4. B) Ils vont à l'école — 'Ils vont' (they go, present of aller) + à l'école (to school)
5. Subject: Je Verb: vais (go, present of aller) Destination: à l'école Sentence: Je vais à l'école
6. Subject: Ils Verb: viennent (come, present of venir) Time: demain Sentence: Ils viennent demain
7. Subject: Nous Verb: allons (go) Destination: à Paris Time: la semaine prochaine Sentence: Nous allons à Paris la semaine prochaine
8. 'Aller' means 'to go'. Present: je vais, tu vas, il/elle va
9. 'Venir' means 'to come'. Present: je viens, tu viens, il/elle vient
10. Both are irregular verbs. Their conjugations do not follow standard patterns.

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
