

What are Interrogative Pronouns?

Interrogative pronouns introduce questions by asking 'who,' 'what,' 'which,' or 'whom.' French forms include qui (who/whom), que/quoi (what), lequel/laquelle (which one), and combinations like duquel/desquels depending on gender and number.

Answer Key

1. A) qui — qui is the standard interrogative for 'who,' asking about the subject.
2. B) quoi — quoi is used after prepositions: à quoi, de quoi, pour quoi.
3. B) laquelle — laquelle = which one, feminine singular.
4. A) Qui as-tu vu? — Qui as-tu vu? asks about the object person (whom); que asks about non-living things.
5. Qui est à la porte? (subject question: asking about the person doing the action)
6. Lequel préfères-tu? (asking to choose between items; laquelle if feminine, lesquels/lesquelles if plural)
7. De quoi parles-tu? (object question after preposition: à quoi, de quoi, pour quoi)
8. Question words asking about people, things, or choices: qui, que, lequel, etc.
9. qui (both subject and object, context determines meaning)
10. que = used without preposition; quoi = used after a preposition (à quoi, de quoi).

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
