

What is the Near Future (Aller + Infinitive)?

Worksheet

The near future combines present aller + infinitive: je vais parler, tu vas manger, il va regarder. It expresses plans, intentions and things happening soon.

Questions

1. Conjugate aller for 'je' in present tense.
A) je vais
B) je aller
C) je allé
D) je va
2. Near future of 'manger' (to eat) for 'nous'?
A) Nous allons manger
B) Nous vont manger
C) Nous mangerons
D) Nous mangeons
3. Complete: 'Ils ___ regarder un film' (near future).
A) vont
B) va
C) allons
D) aller
4. In near future, the infinitive...
A) does not conjugate
B) conjugates like normal
C) changes to past participle
D) takes subject-verb inversion
5. Write the near future: 'I am going to eat an apple.'
6. Make near future: 'They are going to watch a film' (ils).

Answer Key

1. A) je vais — 'Je vais' is the correct present form of aller for je.
2. A) Nous allons manger — 'Nous allons manger' — nous allons + infinitive.
3. A) vont — 'Ils vont regarder' — third person plural of aller + infinitive.
4. A) does not conjugate — The infinitive never conjugates in near future; aller does all the conjugation.
5. aller (present) + infinitive je vais + manger Result: Je vais manger une pomme.
6. aller (present) + infinitive ils vont + regarder Result: Ils vont regarder un film.
7. aller (present) + infinitive tu vas + parler Result: Tu vas parler.
8. aller (present) + infinitive: je vais parler (I am going to speak).
9. Conjugate aller in present, then add the infinitive: je vais + manger = je vais manger.
10. Tu vas regarder (You are going to watch).
