Answer Key

1. A) te — Te is the direct object pronoun for 'you' (informal).
2. C) leur — Leur is the indirect object pronoun for 'them'.
3. C) nous — Nous is the object pronoun for 'us' (both direct and indirect).
4. C) lui — Lui is the indirect object pronoun for 'her' or 'him'.
5. Identify the object: Marie (direct object) Replace with la (her): Pierre aime la.
6. Object = le livre → le; indirect object = à Anne → lui Nous le lui donnons. (We give it to her.)
7. Pronoun for 'them' in indirect object = leur Sentence: Je leur parle. (I speak to them.)
8. Je. It performs the action.
9. Te. Example: Je te vois (I see you).
10. Direct object pronoun meaning 'him' or 'it'.
