1. B) gouvernement — Gouvernement = government. Politique = politics; élection = election; état = state.
2. B) election — Élection = election — the democratic voting process.
3. C) citizen — Citoyen = citizen — a member of a state with rights and duties.
4. C) liberté — Liberté = freedom. Droit = right, état = state, nation = nation.
5. Citizens = les citoyens Right = le droit Vote = voter (verb), le vote (noun) Elections = les élections French: 'Les citoyens ont le droit de voter aux élections.'
6. Gouvernement = government, Politique = policy/politics Sentence: 'Le gouvernement a proposé une nouvelle politique environnementale.'
7. Liberté = liberty, freedom In context: 'La liberté de parole est un droit fondamental.'
8. Government — the system or body that governs a state.
9. Election — a democratic process to choose officials or representatives.
10. Citizen — a member of a state or nation with certain rights and duties.
