

What are Reflexive Pronouns?

Reflexive pronouns (me, te, se, nous, vous) are used with reflexive verbs to show an action directed back at the subject itself, such as se lever (to get up) or s'appeler (to be called).

Answer Key

1. A) me — Me is the reflexive pronoun for 'je'.
2. B) se laver — Se laver (to wash oneself) is reflexive.
3. C) se — Se is the reflexive pronoun for 'elle/il'.
4. B) The reflexive pronoun — A reflexive pronoun (me, te, se) makes a verb reflexive.
5. Reflexive pronoun for 'je' = me Conjugate: Je me lève. (I get up.)
6. Reflexive pronoun for 'nous' = nous Conjugate: Nous nous endormons. (We fall asleep.)
7. Reflexive pronoun for 'elle' = se Sentence: Elle s'appelle Marie. (She is called Marie.)
8. A pronoun that shows the action is performed on the subject itself.
9. Me. Example: Je me lève (I get up).
10. Se. Example: Il se lave (He washes).

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
