

What are French Sports and Hobbies?

French sports include le football (football), le tennis (tennis), la natation (swimming), and la danse (dance). Each noun has a gender — always use the correct article (le/la/les).

1. Which article goes with 'football'?
A) la football
B) le football
C) les football
D) un football
2. How do you say 'I play tennis' in French?
A) Je joue le tennis
B) Je joue au tennis
C) Je joue de tennis
D) Je tennis
3. What is 'la danse'?
A) dancing
B) a dance club
C) a dancer
D) to dance
4. Which word means 'hobby' or 'leisure activity'?
A) sport
B) loisir
C) jeu
D) activité
5. How do you ask someone 'What is your hobby?' in French?
6. Say 'I play tennis' in French.
7. Say 'I love swimming' in French.
8. Define: le football
9. Define: la natation
10. Define: jouer à

Answer Key

1. B) le football — Le football — football is masculine. Use 'le' (the).
2. B) Je joue au tennis — Jouer à + sport. 'À + le' contracts to 'au' → 'Je joue au tennis.'
3. A) dancing — La danse = dancing (the noun, feminine). The verb is 'danser'.
4. B) loisir — Loisir = hobby/leisure. All are related, but 'loisir' is most like 'hobby'.
5. Use 'Quel est ton hobby?' Or more naturally: 'Quel est ton loisir préféré?' Loisir = leisure, préféré = favorite
6. Use the verb 'jouer' (to play) + à + sport 'Je joue au tennis.' (Je = I, joue = play, au = à + le)
Note: à + le = au (contraction)
7. 'J'aime la natation.' J'aime = I love, la natation = swimming Note: natation is feminine (la)
8. soccer/football (masculine)
9. swimming (feminine)
10. to play (a sport) — 'jouer au tennis'

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
