

# What is French Weather Vocabulary?

## Worksheet

French weather vocabulary describes atmospheric conditions and seasons. Essential terms include: le soleil (sun), la pluie (rain), la neige (snow), le vent (wind), and seasons like le printemps (spring), l'été (summer), l'automne (fall), and l'hiver (winter).

## Answer Key

1. B) le soleil — 'Le soleil' = sun (masculine). 'Lune' = moon, 'étoile' = star, 'ciel' = sky.
2. B) Il fait froid — 'Il fait froid' = It is cold. 'Chaud' = hot, 'pleut' = raining, 'neige' = snowing.
3. B) l'automne — 'L'automne' (fall/autumn) comes after 'l'été' (summer). Printemps = spring, hiver = winter.
4. C) l'hiver — 'L'hiver' = winter (masculine). Others: fall, summer, spring.
5. Sun = le soleil Sentence: Il fait du soleil. (or C'est ensoleillé) = It is sunny.
6. Example: L'été est ma saison préférée. Explanation: Summer is my favorite season.
7. Rain = la pluie (or raining = il pleut) Sentence: Il pleut aujourd'hui. = It is raining today.
