Answer Key

1. A) sieben — 7 is 'sieben'. Siebzehn (17) and sechzehn (16) are longer numbers.
2. A) zwölf — 12 is 'zwölf', which is one of the irregular numbers you must memorize.
3. A) neunzehn — 19 is 'neunzehn' (neun + zehn = 9 + 10).
4. A) acht — 8 is 'acht'. Achtzehn (18) is 8 + 10.
5. The number 5 is 'fünf' in German. Example: Ich habe fünf Äpfel. (I have five apples.)
6. 13 is 'dreizehn' in German. It's formed by: drei (3) + zehn (10) = dreizehn. Example: Das Kind ist dreizehn Jahre alt. (The child is 13 years old.)
7. The number 20 is 'zwanzig' in German. Example: Es kostet zwanzig Euro. (It costs twenty euros.)
