

# What are Extended Question Words?

## Worksheet

Extended question words (wofür, womit, worüber, etc.) combine a preposition + wer or was into one word for asking 'with what', 'about what', 'why' and similar questions.

## Questions

1. wofür = ?
  - A) for what

2. 'Womit schreibst du?' means...
  - A) What are you thinking about?

## Answer Key

1. A) for what — für + was = wofür (for what).
2. B) What are you writing with? — mit + was = womit (with what).
3. B) über + was — über (about) + was = worüber.
4. B) wofür — wofür is a preposition + was combination.
5. Preposition: über (about) Combine: über + was = worüber Question: Worüber denkt sie nach?
6. Preposition: mit (with) Combine: mit + was = womit Question: Womit schreibst du?
7. Preposition: für (for) Combine: für + was = wofür Question: Wofür ist das gut?
8. Combinations of preposition + was (or wer) into one question word.
9. Wofür machst du das? (für + was = wofür).
10. Saying the preposition and was separately.
