1. B) Mutter — Mutter = mother. Vater = father.
2. B) der — Bruder is masculine: der Bruder.

4. A) Meine Eltern — Eltern (parents) is plural feminine: meine Eltern.
5. Meine Mutter und mein Vater sind beide Lehrer. (Possessive adjective 'meine/mein' + family term + verb)
6. Ich habe einen älteren Bruder und eine jüngere Schwester. (Adjective + family noun in accusative)
7. Das ist meine Schwester. (Feminine noun; possessive 'meine')
8. mother; feminine, always die Mutter
9. father; masculine, always der Vater
10. brother; masculine, always der Bruder

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
