3. B) A brief indication of your two main reasons — After stating your opinion, briefly preview the reasons you'll develop in body paragraphs.
4. C) Restate your opinion and summarize main points — The conclusion reinforces your position and briefly recap the key reasons you've presented.
5. Introduction: Paraphrase the statement and state your opinion: I agree that technological advancement brings significant benefits. Body 1: Healthcare: Technology has improved diagnosis and treatment. For example, AI-powered scanners detect diseases earlier, saving lives. Body 2: Communication: Technology connects people globally. For instance, remote work allows people to collaborate across continents. Conclusion: In conclusion, the advantages of technology in healthcare and communication clearly demonstrate its beneficial impact on society.
6. Introduction: While university education is valuable, I believe success can be achieved through multiple paths. Body 1: Entrepreneurship: Many successful entrepreneurs like Steve Jobs and Mark Zuckerberg achieved success without completing traditional degrees. Body 2: Vocational Training: Skilled trades such as plumbing and electrical work offer high income and job security without university degrees. Conclusion: Therefore, while university is one route, alternative paths including entrepreneurship and vocational training are equally valid for achieving success.
7. Introduction: I partially agree that remote work should be available, but not suitable for all jobs. Body 1: Benefits: Remote work improves work-life balance. Studies show that employees working from home report higher satisfaction and productivity. Body 2: Limitations: Some jobs require physical presence. For example, surgeons, teachers, and construction workers cannot effectively work remotely. Conclusion: In summary, remote work is beneficial for suitable roles, but a flexible approach recognizing job-specific needs is most practical.
