Konuşmacı tutumunu tanıma, dinlenen materyaldeki tonlama, vurgu ve kullanılan kelimeler aracılığıyla konuşmacının olumlu, olumsuz, şüpheli, tarafsız veya coşkulu olup olmadığını belirleme stratejisidir.

2. A professor comments on a student's research paper: "This is a thoroughly researched and well-argued piece. You've clearly put a lot of effort into it, and the conclusions are very insightful."

3. During a debate, one participant states, "While I understand the opposing viewpoint, the data presented does not fully support their claims."

Cevap Anahtarı

1. C) Skeptical and disappointed — The words 'supposed to' (expectation) contrasted with 'actually slower' (negative reality) and the conjunction 'but' indicate skepticism and disappointment.
2. C) Positive and impressed — Phrases like 'thoroughly researched,' 'well-argued,' 'lot of effort,' and 'insightful' all convey strong positive feedback and admiration.
3. C) Expresses doubt about the claims — The phrase 'does not fully support' indicates a lack of complete agreement and suggests doubt regarding the validity of the claims.
4. Listen for keywords like 'promising' (positive) and 'significant hurdle' (negative). The contrast indicates a cautious or critical attitude regarding current efficiency.
5. Identify emotional language: 'staring for hours,' 'not making sense,' 'completely overwhelming.' These indicate frustration and a negative attitude.
6. Focus on neutral phrasing: 'presented its reasoning,' 'consider all aspects,' 'before forming a judgment.' This suggests a neutral or objective stance.
7. Excellent, wonderful, great, impressive, beneficial, promising, advantage, support, approve, agree
8. Problematic, difficult, concerning, disappointing, drawback, criticize, oppose, disagree, inadequate, insufficient
9. However, but, although, perhaps, maybe, question, doubt, consider, investigate, uncertain
